The Blue Devils Performing Arts Scholarship Guidelines

Approved 2/16/93

- 1. Dedicated to the pursuit of competitive excellence through the disciplines of the arts.
- the applicant must have participated in two competitive years in The Blue Devils prior to January 1 of the application year.

Participation is defined as performing in at least on half of the competitive shows for a particular unit.

A Scholarship recipient must have performed in at least on half of a unit's current year's competitive shows to be eligible for the award.

To qualify in any unit, that unit must be recognized as being actively competitive for that particular season.

- 3. A recommendation from the applicant's unit manager will be required. This recommendation will evaluate the applicant's commitment to The Blue Devils, and may include such issues as attitude, bingo and other corps support
- 4. the applicant must be in good financial standing with The Blue Devils, and must be current on all fees or dues that are payable to The Blue Devils.
- 5. Preference will be given to applicants with performing arts majors and longevity in The Blue Devils.
- 6. The applicant must be in his/her senior year of high school or already attending a college or university or a trade/vocational school specializing in the performing arts.
- 7. The recipient must be enrolled in at least 12 class units at a college or university or a trade/vocational school specializing in the performing arts. This information must be submitted by June 1 of the year following application or the recipient will not be eligible for the award. Individuals who fail to meet this criteria will lose the award, but may reapply.
- 8. Scholarship(s) granted will be paid by check written to the recipient. The recipient must first provide verification of enrollment in twelve (12) class units as specified in #7 above. The recipient must also have met his/her participation requirement as stated in #2 above.
- 9. The scholarship committee is free to award up to three \$500 scholarships. The number of scholarships awarded would depend upon receiving qualified applications. The scholarship committee may elect not to award any scholarships if no qualified applications are received.

- 10. The scholarship will be ranted for one year only. Previous Blue Devils' scholarship recipients are not eligible for a second award.
- 11. All applicants will be notified, prior to the annual Blue devils' Family Day, as to the outcome of his/her application. Announcement of scholarship recipient(s) will be made at The Blue Devils Family Day show.
